**Seven's programmes dominate nominations
for this year's Golden Globe Awards**

Commander In Chief, Prison Break and My Name Is Earl join Desperate Housewives, Lost and Grey's Anatomy as the Seven Network programmes to be recognised in today's nominations for the forthcoming Golden Globe Awards.

All four housewives in Desperate Housewives – Marcia Cross, Teri Hatcher, Felicity Huffman and Eva Longoria - have been nominated in the actress (comedy) category.

Patrick Dempsey (Grey's Anatomy), Matthew Fox (Lost), Wentworth Miller (Prison Break) and Keifer Sutherland are nominated in the actor (drama) category

Seven scored four of the five nominations in the drama category: Grey's Anatomy, Lost, Commander in Chief and Prison Break. My Name Is Earl joins Desperate Housewives as a nominee in the comedy category.
