Seven is number 1 in primetime.

- Seven wins primetime in total viewers, 18-49s and 25-54s.
- Seven is up 29% on Nine and up 47% on Ten in total viewers. Seven is up 36% on Nine in 16-39s. Seven is up 34% on Nine and up 11% on Ten in 18-49s. Seven is up 34% on Nine and up 30% on Ten in 25-54s.
- Seven dominates the top-rating programmes – with the number 1, top 6, 8 of the top 10 and 16 of the top 20
- Seven sweeps the week: number 1 on Sunday, Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday, Friday and Saturday.

Seven is number 1 for the television year-to-date.

Seven wins another week in total viewers, 18-49s and 25-54s.
